RULES & REGULATIONS — 500 Club Tournament

1. This shall be a singles handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% of 225 scratch. Three games to be bowled on one pair of lanes. Tournament is USBC certified and all USBC rules and regulations will govern. Only USBC certified female members may participate and they must have bowled a 500 series in their lifetime. Current (2009-2010) USBC membership card must be presented at the time of check in.
2. Entry Fee shall be \$22.00 per person.
3. Each participant may enter only once.
4. Prize monies will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least one prize for each 10 entries. Trophies shall be awarded for high game with handicap and high series with handicap. In the event of a tie for first place, duplicate prizes will be awarded and first and second place prize monies will be combined and divided equally.
5. Entering Average: The highest USBC average from the 2008-2009 season shall be used. If no yearbook average, highest league average of 21 games or more as of December 1, 2009, (Attach verification). All others must bowl scratch (225).
6. It shall be the player's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or prize winnings will be based on submitted average if it is higher. Corrections in average may be made up to completion of first game.
7. Bowlers arriving late shall start in the frame being bowled. Zero shall be given for each frame missed.
8. No entry fees returned after closing date of tournament entries.
9. USBC Rule 319d (reporting prize winnings) does not apply.
10. USBC Rule 319a(2) (10 pin rule) does not apply.
11. USBC Rule 319e (average adjustment rule) does not apply.
12. Participants must check in at tournament office one hour before starting time.
13. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
