

(Please tear off entry form on front and **save the top half of form** for yourself. This is verification of your entry, unless you send a self-addressed envelope – no other forms will be sent to you.)

RULES:

1. Entries open December 12, 2011 and **must be postmarked** by January 18, 2012. **No refunds** will be issued after tournament entry deadline.
2. Entry fee is based on the following: Bowling fee - \$7.00, Prize fund - \$15.00, and Club expenses- \$3.00 – totaling an entry fee of \$25.00.
3. **All U.S.B.C. rules not specifically listed will apply.**
4. 90% of 220 Scratch will be used to compute the handicap for this tournament.
5. Entrants must use the highest certified league average of 21 games or more in any winter or summer league as published in the 2010-2011 yearbook, and/or as reported on bowl.com. If no previous season average, entrant will be allowed to use the highest current **U.S.B.C.** certified league average for 12 games or more as of the tournament date. Proof of average must be supplied with entry. Entrant without either average bowls scratch. It is the bowlers' responsibility to verify their average. Failure to do so could result in disqualification. **U.S.B.C.** Tournament rule 319-A3 will apply. Rules 319-A2, 319-D and 319-E are waived.
6. All entrants must be certified through **U.S.B.C.** and must be members of the National and the Pontiac 600 clubs. If you are not a current member of the National 600 Club, you can contact your **league** secretary to apply. Pontiac 600 Club **yearly dues of \$5.00** should be submitted with entry or can be paid at the tournament desk. **Yearly dues are valid January-December of each year.**
7. Awards and money will be returned 100% to participants. There will be at least 1 (one) prize for each 10 (ten) bowler entries or a fraction thereof. Awards will be given in the following order:
 - High Actual Game
 - High Handicap Game
 - High Actual Series
 - High Handicap SeriesIn case of a tie(s), duplicate awards will be given and the prize money divided equally. You may win only 1 (one) award.
8. **BOWLERS MUST CHECK IN PRIOR TO 11:30 AM** with **U.S.B.C** certification card or payment receipt and National 600 Card. Any bowler(s) arriving after a game has started, will be allowed to bowl for score starting in the frame they arrive. A score of '0' for each frame missed will be given.
9. Substitute(s) will be allowed. Walk-in bowlers will be allowed in lieu of absent bowlers, and/or if space is available. Bowler will be required to pay entry and yearly dues, if applicable. Rule #5 will apply.
10. No "Card Carrying Pro" may participate in this tournament.
