ERIN WILLIAMS REPEATS IN THE WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT VAN DYKE BOWL

Erin Williams of Warren won the third Metro Detroit USBC Association (MDUSBC) Rip 10 Entertainment Women's Series event, sponsored by Blumark, on Sunday with a 229-155 triumph over Rebecca Smith of Lansing at Van Dyke Bowl in Utica. Williams took home the top prize of \$500, while Smith settled for \$250. This was the second event in a row that Williams prevailed.

Williams qualified fifth in the field of 49 with a four-game total of 874. Her qualifying total included a first game of 258.

Once in match play she dispatched Nicole Edwards of Sterling Heights 258-230, Kathleen Bishop of Westland 246-197 and top qualifier Lisa Bishop of Belleville 300-184 en route to the championship match.

Smith qualified 10th with 836. Her victories in match play included wins over Sara Litteral of Eastpointe 210-160, Pamela Wilson of Dearborn Heights 216-213 and Valandrea Elliott-Frazier of Redford 229-210.

Bishop was the top qualifier with 986 and leads the Blumark cup standings with 293 points through three of the six events.
