SHANNON ROWE WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL

Shannon Rowe was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 239-213 triumph over Sara Litteral of Redford at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Rowe took home the top prize of \$500 while Litteral earned \$250.

Rowe qualified third in the field of 33 with a four-game total of 868 on games of 207, 246, 213 and 202. In reaching the finals against LItteral, she beat Erica Kozicki of Sterling Heights 201-193 and Nicole Harrison of Clinton Twp. 204-201 on her way to the finals.

Litteral qualified fifth with 863, which included games of 225, 164, 226 and 248. In reaching the finals against Rowe, she defeated Julie Oczepek of Vassar 247-224 and Sandra Schultz of Macomb 204-177.

Schultz was the top qualifier with a four game total of 906 on games of 235, 226, 236 and 209. In losing to Litteral in the second round of match play, Schultz took home \$100.
