MDUSBC MASTERS QUALIFYING SET FOR BOWL ONE LANES

The Metro Detroit USBC Association Masters Tournament is scheduled for Bowl One Lanes in Troy with qualifying set for Saturday and Sunday, Jan. 21-22.

Qualifying will be conducted in two squads on both days. After the 10 games of qualifying are completed the top players will join defending champion John Nolen of Waterford will return for double elimination match play on Saturday, Jan. 28. The top eight players after the first day of match play will come back on Sunday, Jan. 29 to complete the competition. Matches consist of three games total pins.

First place will pay \$3,000 with \$2,000 for runner-up based on 140 entries.

Former champions entered are Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford Township (2005 and 2007) and Terence Dockery of Fraser (1993).
