SARAH DOROW WINS WOMEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Sarah Dorow of Midland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 224-162 triumph over Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. Dorow took home the top prize of \$500, while Giardina earned \$250.

Dorow was the third qualifier in the invitational field of 15 with a four-game total of 801 on games of 191, 211, 203 and 196 to advance to the stepladder competition.

In her first match, Dorow beat Darlene Dysart of Southfield 238-210. Dysart cashed for \$100. In her second match, she beat Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 220-170 before advancing to the final match. Reamy-Johnson earned \$150.

Giardina was the top qualifier with 855 on games of 175, 209, 206 and a finishing game of 265 to secure the top spot advancing her to the stepladder finals.

The top 15 bowlers qualified on the points and participation level of the five-event Women's Series and were invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Samantha Rhoads of Allen Park won the Women's Series cup with 809 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Olivia Clark of Jackson with 731 points for \$300 and Julie Oczepek of Vassar with 704 points for \$200.
