CHARLES ZELECHOWSKI WINS MEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Charles Zelechowski of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 211-183 triumph over William Holmes of Southfield. Zelechowski took home the top prize of \$500, while Holmes earned \$250.

Zelechowski was the top qualifier in the invitational field of 28 with a four-game total of 964 on games of 243, 259, 233 and 229 to advance to the stepladder finals and wait for a challenger.

Holmes qualified fourth with 834 on games of 212, 213, 205 and 204. In the stepladder finals he beat Michael Snow of Windsor, Ontario 228-225. Snow cashed for \$100. In his second match, Holmes beat the second place qualifier, Anthony Wright of Detroit 237-203. Wright cashed for \$150.

The invited 28 bowlers qualified based on the points and the participation level for the five-event Men's Series and were then invited to participate in this special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Wright won the Men's Series cup with 715 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Gerald Johnson of Taylor with 672 points for \$300 and Carl Boldt of Pontiac with 653 points for \$200.
