LESIA LAMBERT CAPTURES MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Lesia Lambert of Allen Park won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 204-195 triumph over Sandy Schultz of Macomb at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl) in Waterford.

Lambert was the top qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 913 on games of 245, 201, 212 and 255. As the top seed, she had to wait for the challenger to emerge.

Schultz qualified 2nd with a four game total of 845. Her totals included a high game of 227. She defeated Michelle Turner of Detroit 224-214 to advance to the championship match.

Denise Mintz of Canton qualified 3rd with a four game total of 821 on games of 190, 167, 227 and 235. In first game of match play, she lost to Turner 235-215.

Turner qualified 4th with a four game total of 802 on games of 209, 203, 207 and 183. In the first round of match play she beat Mintz 235-215 before being eliminated by Schultz 224-214.

This was the 15th year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.
