SANDRA SCHULTZ WINS MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT SHORE LANES

Sandra Schultz of Macomb won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 195-185 triumph over Krista Winbigler of Macomb at Shore Lanes in St. Clair Shores.

Schultz was the top qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 918 on games of 226-211-280-201. Schultz took home the top prize of \$250.

Winbigler was the second qualifier for the stepladder finals with 911. Winbigler settled for \$160.

Winbigler advanced to the finals with a 251-195 victory over two-time defending champion Carmeletha Allen of Highland Park.

Allen earlier had beaten Consuelo Cleveland of Westland 205-158. Allen took home \$130 and Cleveland \$100 for their efforts.

This was the ninth year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.

Other cashers for \$80 each were Michelle Turner of Detroit, Pamela Jones of Livonia, Belenda House of Detroit and Kim Harris of Redford. Cashing for \$75 were Carolyn Wilson of Roseville and Karol Bogues of Royal Oak.

The MDUSBC Senior Queens Tournament is operated by the Metro Detroit USBC which serves nearly 50,000 adult and youth bowlers in the Metropolitan Detroit market and is the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress.
