CONNER WEBER WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Conner Weber of Wayne won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 258-229 triumph over Steve Kenyon of Grosse Ile at Westland Bowl in Westland. Weber took home the top prize of \$500, while Kenyon settled for \$250.

Weber qualified second in the field of 53, with a four-game total of 905 on games of 244, 245, 213 and 203. In match play he defeated Harold Sullins of Chesterfield 224-212 and Phillip Zocharski of Chelsea 221-207 to advance to the championship match.

Kenyon qualified 13th with 821, including a high game of 226. In match play he beat Corey Miller of Waterford 247-212, Zachary Colosimo of Farmington Hills 198-176 and Mason Brantley of Detroit 237-225 on his way to the finals.

Michael McCleskey of Southfield led the field for the second time this season with 908 on games of 243, 205, 213 and 247. He lost his first match to Brantley 206-203 and took home \$75.
