## STEPHEN KRYWY WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT MAYFLOWER LANES

Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 253-170 triumph over January's winner Lonnie Jones of Ann Arbor at Mayflower Lanes in Redford. Krywy took home the top prize of \$500, while Jones settled for \$250.

Krywy qualified 9<sup>th</sup> with a four-game total of 830 in the field of 48, on games of 233, 206, 204 and 187. In match play he beat Michael Hitchcock of Garden City 241-176, top qualifier John Bercier of Spring Lake 224-216 and Andrew Charrette of Harrison Township 266-226 to advance to the championship match. As a result of his win he took over the lead in the cup race with 501 points.

Jones qualified second with 885. Because of this qualifying he was seeded into the second round. Once there he beat Lonnie Olsen of Warren 245-148 and David Alexander Jr. of Wyandotte 211-195 on his way to the finals.

Krywy leads the cup race with 501 points, followed by Gerald Johnson of Taylor with 458 and Olsen with 431.
