## JENNIFER KREFT WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT TEN PINS OF TRENTON

Jennifer Kreft of Warren won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 202-192 triumph over Kathleen Bishop of Westland at Ten Pins of Trenton in Trenton. Kreft took home the top prize of \$500, while Bishop settled for \$250.

Kreft qualified second in the field of 30 with a four-game total of 865, which included a high game of 254, to earn a bye in the first round. In match play she defeated last month's champion Nicole Harrison of Shelby Township 186-183 and Kristin Truszkowski of Livonia 223-191 on her way to the finals.

Bishop qualified fourth with 826. She beat Rebecca Keegan of Carleton 60-32 in a ninth and tenth frame roll off after tying at 222. She then went on to beat top qualifier Julie Oczepek of Reese 199-192 to advance to the finals.

Oczepek led the field with 911 on games of 223, 268, 205 and 215. She finished third for \$100.
