BRANDIE REAMY WINS HER THIRD WOMEN'S SERIES TITLE AT MAYFLOWER LANES

Brandie Reamy of Livonia won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 213-195 triumph over Haley Lundy of Lasalle, Ontario at Mayflower Lanes in Redford. Reamy took home the top prize of \$500, while Lundy settled for \$250.

Reamy qualified second in the field of 27, with a four-game total of 902. In qualifying she was consistent with a high game of 244. In match play she beat Nicole Harrison of Shelby Township 210-191 and Tanisha Burris of Holt 191-163 to advance to the finals. This was Reamy's second Women's Series title this season and third overall. This also propelled her to the lead of the MDUSBC Cup standings with 536 points, a lead of 17 over second place Lisa Bishop of Redford.

Lundy qualified fourth with 876, with a high game of 258. She triumphed over Jennifer Maples of Warren 210-1754 and Lisa Bishop 236-215 on her way to the finals. She moved up to fourth place in the cup race with 484 points.

Lisa Bishop was the top qualifier with 939 on games of 232, 258, 233 and 216.

The next MDUSBC Women's Series event will be April 9 at Ford Lanes in Dearborn Heights.
