- 4. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:
 - A) A refund will be given, less \$25 cancellation fee, if written notice is received by October 29, 2022.
 - B) No refund will be given if written notice is received after October 29, 2022
 - c) Those who withdraw/cancel may obtain their own replacements. Bowlers who obtain replacements will make their own arrangements as to repayment of their individual entry fees.
 - D) Tournament Director must be notified of replacements prior to 5:00 PM on November 4, 2022 No replacements will be permitted after the tournament begins.

Michigan State USBC Queens Tournament

General Rules, Regulations and Information

- 1. This is an individual scratch tournament open only to certified Female Michigan State USBC members.
- 2. Entry fee is \$ 100.00. Walk-in fee is \$110.00. Entire entry to be applied to prize fund and prize fund will be returned 100%. Rule 319d is waived.
- 3. Participant may enter tournament only once. Walk-ins will be accepted based on lane availability Walk-in entry fee is \$110.00. Walk-ins will be accepted no later than **one hour prior** to the start of the tournament.
- 4. Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR before first scheduled time to bowl, to draw for lane assignments, and one-half hour prior to each squad thereafter.
- 5. Qualifying rounds will be as follows:
 - a. FIRST ROUND: All Bowlers

Saturday 10:00 am.- 5 games bowled

Saturday 2:00 pm.- 5 games bowled

Each bowler will bowl two-five game blocks. The 10-game total pinfall will be used to qualify for the Second Round (Sunday morning).

Top eight qualifiers will advance to match play on Sunday morning.

All advancers to receive prize money.

- b. <u>SECOND ROUND</u>: Eight bowlers (Sunday 10:00 am). Carrying pin count forward, each bowler will bowl eight games across eight lanes in match play format with the eighth game being the position round. Thirty bonus points will be awarded for a win and fifteen bonus points will be awarded for a tie for each game bowled. The Top four will advance to the Stepladder Final Round.
- c. <u>FINAL ROUND</u>-Stepladder Format: Four bowlers. The four finalists will compete in one game matches
 in Stepladder format on one pair of lanes to determine the 2022 Michigan Queens Tournament
 Champion.
- 6. Entrants may not practice on tournament lanes on the day of qualifying.
- 7. Schedule Arrangements: After the first round of qualifying, qualifiers will be scheduled according to a prearranged format.
- 8. Queens Tournament Champion will receive a Tiara, a Medallion and if eligible, a paid entry into the next year's Queens Tournament from the Michigan State USBC. In addition, a paid entry into the USBC Queens Tournament (valid for one year 2023 or 2024 tournament) will be reimbursed upon proof of entry into same.

General Rules, Regulations and Information continued

- 9. The application of any foreign substance on any part of the approach that detracts from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, talcum powder, pumice, EZ slide and resin on shoes and/or soft rubber soles or heels that rub off on the approach
- a. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by use of abrasives after the start of competition is prohibited. Please refer to USBC Rule #18.
- b. In each series, the start of competition is defined as the point the first ball is thrown by any participant for score.
- 10. In the Michigan Queen's tournament, entrants are requested to wear suitable attire. **(No Jeans).** Headgear may be worn for medical purposes only.

RULES FOR QUALIFYING ROUNDS:

- 1. If a bowler has not checked in thirty minutes prior to the scheduled time for her first five game block, she may be replaced.
- 2. A bowler who has not checked in fifteen minutes prior to her scheduled time for her second five game block may be disqualified and her entry and entry fee forfeited.
- 3. If in the qualifying rounds the final position needed to complete the field or alternate should result in a tie, one complete game shall immediately be bowled. Failure of any bowler to be available in the bowling center in case of a tie will constitute a forfeiture. Bowlers will draw for lanes with the bowler on the odd lane starting the roll-off in match play format.

If a tie exists at the end of match play for first place, a one game roll-off will be held to determine the stepladder order.

If a Tie still exists at the end of a roll-off, a complete 9th and 10th frame will be bowled. The frames will be bowled on the same lanes on which each bowler finished the 10th frame.

If a tie still exists, bowlers will change lanes and bowl another complete 10th frame. This procedure will be followed until the tie is broken.

4. All other questions will be decided by the Tournament Committee

Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, national disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Michigan State USBC WBA shall cause, to the extend required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective rounds up to the time of such termination.
