GERALD JOHNSON WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Gerald Johnson of Taylor was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 255-223 triumph over Michael Pupin of Chesterfield at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Johnson took home the top prize of \$600 while Pupin earned \$300.

Johnson qualified 16th in the field of 77 with a four-game total of 883 on games of 206, 213, 243 and 221. In reaching the finals against Pupin, he beat Ryan Land of Royal Ok 251-238, Matthew Bederka of Romulus 222-172, Zakarey Geer of Madison Heights 222-201 and in a roll off, Noah Samuels of Canton 278-277.

Pupin qualified 15th with 889, which included games of 206, 257, 247 and 179. In reaching the finals against Johnson, he defeated Robert Wood Jr. of Waterford 211-210, Nathan Roberts of Allen Park 247-170, Ronnie Sparks Jr. of Redford 229-223 and Drake Bazzy of Flat Rock 246-209.

Bederka qualified first with a four-game total of 1,035 on games of 234, 203, 300 and 298. The next highest game behind Bederka was rolled by Samuels with 289.
