ANNA MAXWELL WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Anna Maxwell of Westland claims back to back victories in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 243-236 triumph over Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Maxwell took home the top prize of \$600 while Giardina earned \$300.

Maxwell qualified second in the field of 39 with a four-game total of 924 on games of 233, 227, 205 and 259. In reaching the finals against Giardina, she beat Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 246-213 and Sandra Schultz of Macomb 202-170.

Giardina qualified fourth with 914, which included games of 214, 214, 200 and 286. In reaching the finals against Maxwell, she defeated Jenna Pollak of Fraser 223-197 and Mykaela Hunter of Windsor, Ont. 189-179

Giardina had the high game of the day with 286, followed by Hunter with 279 and Schultz with 278.
