TIFFANY GRIFFITH WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Tiffany Griffith of Kitchener, Ont. won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 235-207 triumph over Denisyha Waller of Shelby Twp. at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Griffith took home the top prize of \$600 while Waller earned \$300.

Griffith qualified seventh in the field of 24 with a four-game total of 776 on games of 211, 169, 193 and 203. In reaching the finals against Waller, she beat Leena Childs of Detroit 196-168 and Pamela Wilson of Woodhaven 257-156.

Waller qualified fourth with 807, which included games of 223, 190, 201 and 193. In reaching the finals against Griffith, she defeated Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. 235-183 and Autumn Riley of Madison Heights 269-151.

High game of the day, 276, went to Bailey Gipson of Davison. She was also the high qualifier with 876. In her first round of Match Play, Gipson lost to Riley 223-180.
