## **OSBORN WINS MEN'S "TURBO CUP" SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES**

Devon Osborn of Farmington Hills won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 237-212 triumph over Gerald Johnson of Taylor. Osborn took home the top prize of \$600 while Johnson earned \$300.

Osborn was the top qualifier in the field of 22 bowlers with 975 on games of 235, 214, 268 and 258. In being the top qualifier of the stepladder finals, Osborn had secured a position in the final match.

Johnson qualified fourth in the invitational field with a four-game total of 917 on games of 245, 242, 198 and 232. In reaching the finals, Johnson beat Zach Kilbourne of Linden 225-180 and Lamont Walters II of Redford 259-210. Kilbourne finished fourth and earned \$100 while Walters finished third for \$150.

The invited bowlers qualified for the Invitational at Shelby Lanes based on the points earned during the typically five-event series, winning at least one event during the season or bowling every in every event. However, the second event this year was cancelled due to a power outage and not rescheduled.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Noah Samuels of Canton earned \$600 as the season champion with 675 points over the Men's Turbo Cup four-event series for this year, followed by Johnson with 634 points for \$300 and Matt Rist of Garden City with 612 points for \$200.
