RANDY WARNKEN WINS MDUSBC SENIOR MASTERS AND CLAIMS \$2,000 FIRST PRIZE AT PLAZA LANES

Randy Warnken of Clinton Twp. won the 33rd Annual Metro Detroit USBC Senior Masters Tournament in defeating Jeff Kendall of Clawson 494-463. In claiming the title, Warnken was the lone survivor in the winner's bracket and claimed the \$2,000 first prize. Kendall earned the second-place check of \$1,000.

Warnken qualified first in the field of 98 with a six-game total of 1,502 and a high game of 279. In match play, he defeated Justin Jeffery of Lincoln Park 462-450, defending champion Steve Kenyon of Grosse Ile 504-466, Gerald Johnson of Taylor 526-475 and Stacy Keith of New Boston 513-420 to advance to the final match and victory over Kendall. Throughout the two days of competition, Warnken averaged 250.06 for 16 games.

Kendall qualified 21st with a six-game total of 1,362 and a high game of 268. In match play, he defeated Michael Calvin of Macomb 503-437 before losing to Brian Thompson of Flat Rock 465-449. In the loser's bracket, he defeated Joseph Krajenke of Clinton Twp. 462-369, Jerry Choate of Flat Rock 460-411, Lonnie Olsen of Macomb 520-439, Troy Stus of South Lyon 455-423, Johnson 441-428, Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford 474-473 and Keith 395-362 setting up the match against Warnken in the finals. Throughout the competition, Kendall averaged 230.15 over 26 games.

Keith finished third and started the Match Play rounds as the 22nd qualifier with a six-game total of 1,361 and a high game of 257. In match play, he defeated Krajenke 428-346, Glenn Ludeman of Chesterfield 474-395, Olsen 409-351 and Robert Sloma of Jenison 445-406 before losing his first match to Warnken. In his only game in the loser's bracket he lost to Kendall and was eliminated from competition. Throughout the tournament, Keith averaged 216.61 over 18 games. He took home \$750 for third place.

The high game rolled throughout competition, 290, was rolled by Austreng (game 2 of the Qualifying round), Calvin (game 3 of the Qualifying round) and Johnson (game 2 of the Match Play round).

The MDUSBC Masters Tournament is a USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress which serves over 32,000 adult and youth bowlers in the Metropolitan Detroit market.
