1. To abide by all the rules and regulations of the USBC and such special rules as published for the Michigan Queens Tournament.
2. The Tournament Committee has my unqualified permission to use my photograph for publicity and promotion.
3. If current membership cannot be verified by bowl.com, a USBC full membership must be purchased at the tournament site (USBC \$13, Michigan State USBC \$1.00 and their local association dues).
4. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:
A) A refund will be given, less $\$ 25$ cancellation fee, if written notice is received by April 5, 2019.
B) No refund will be given if written notice is received after April 5, 2019.
C) Those who withdraw/cancel may obtain their own replacements. Bowlers who obtain replacements will make their own arrangements as to repayment of their individual entry fees.
D) Tournament Director must be notified of replacements prior to 5:00 PM on April 12, 2019. No replacements will be permitted after the tournament begins.

## 1. This is an individual scratch toumament open only to certified Female Michigan State USBC members.

2. Unmaried grade and high school students under the age of 18 must have written consent of a parent or guardian before partic ipating in any USBC certified toumament where cash or merchandise prizes are offered. Such consent must be on file with the toumament directorat least one week before participation unless a parent or guardian accompaniesthe student. In that case, the consent form may be filed prior to the start of bowling. Should a USBC Youth bowler partic ipate and qualify for prize money, her winnings must be awarded in the form a scholarship with the funds being sent to the SMART program. She must also have signed the USBC Singles Waiver and by signing acknowledges that her competition could jeopardize her MHSAA eligibility.
3. Entry fee is $\$ 100.00$. Walk-in fee is $\$ 110.00$. Prize fund retumed is $100 \%$. Rule 319d is waived.
4. Partic ipant may enter touma ment only once. Walk-ins will be accepted based on la ne a vaila bility Walkin entry fee is $\$ 110.00$. The $\$ 10.00$ will be added to the prize fund. Walk-ins will be accepted no later than one hour prior to the start of the toumament.
5. Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR before first scheduled time to bowl and one half hour prior to each squad thereafter.
6. Qualifying rounds will be as follows:
a. FRSTROUND: All Bowlers (Saturd ay 10:00 am and 2:00 pm). Each bowler will bowl eight games a cross 16 lanes in two four ga me blocks. The eight game total pinfall will be used to qualify for the Second Round. At least 1 out of 4 will advance to the Second Round. Scorescamy over from the first eight games.
b. SECOND ROUND: $2^{\text {nd }}$ Round Qualifiers (Saturday $6: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ ). Each bowler will bowl one four game block a cross eight lanes. The twelve game total pinfall will be used to qualify for the Third Round. All Second Round Qualifiers will receive prize money.
c. IHIRD ROUND: Eight bowlers (Sunday 10:00 am). Camying pin count forward, each bowler will bowl eight games across eight lanes in match play format with the eighth game being the position round. Thity bonus points will be awarded for a win and fifteen bonus points will be awarded for a tie for each game bowled. The Top four will advance to the Stepladder Final Round.
d. FNALROUND-Stepladder Format: Four bowlers. The four finalists will compete in one game matches in Stepladder format on one pair of lanes to determine the 2019 Michigan Queens Toumament Champion.
7. Entrants may not practice on toumament lanes on the day of qualifying.
8. Schedule Arrangements: After the first round of qualifying, qualifiers will be scheduled according to a prea ranged format.
9. Queens Toumament Champion will receive a Tiara, a Medallion and if eligible, a paid entry into the next year's Queens Toumament from the Mic higan State USBC. In addition, a paid entry into the 2019 USBC Queens Toumament (May 15-21, Wichita, Kansas) will be reimbursed upon proof of entry into same.

10. The application of a ny foreign substance on any part of the a pproach that detracts from the possibility of other players having nomal conditions is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, talc um powder, pumice, EZslide and resin on shoes and/or soft rubber soles or heels that rub off on the approach
a. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by use of abrasives after the start of competition is prohibited. The use of approved cleaning agents such as rubbing alcohol and polishing machines is permissible
b. In each series, the start of competition is defined as the point the first ball is thrown by any partic ipant forscore.
11. In the Mic higan Queen's toumament, entrants are requested to wear suita ble attire. (No J eans). Headgear may be wom formedic al purposes only.

## RUIES FOR QUAUPYING ROUNDS;

1. If a bowler has not checked in thirty minutes prior to the scheduled time for herfirst game block, she may be replaced.
2. A bowler who has not checked in fifteen minutes prior to her scheduled time for her second four game block may be disqualified and her entry and entry fee forfeited.
3. If in the qualifying rounds the final position needed to complete the field or altemate should result in a tie, one complete game shall immediately be bowled. Failure of any bowler to be available in the bowling center in case of a tie will constitute a forfeiture. Bowlers will draw for lanes with the bowleron the odd lane starting the roll-off in match play format.

If a tie exists at the end of match play for first place, a one game roll-off will be held to detemine the stepladder order.

If a Tie still exists at the end of a roll-off, a complete $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame will be bowled. The frames will be bowled on the same lanes on which each bowlerfinished the $10^{\text {th }}$ frame.

If a tie still exists, bowlers will change lanes and bowl a nother complete $10^{\text {thf }}$ frame. This procedure will be followed until the tie is broken.
4. All other questions will be decided by the Touma ment Committee
